SWAN EMERGENCY ALERT CONTACT FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Information in shaded areas will be completed by fire personnel after we receive your form. Someone may contact you for permission to obtain a GPS reading at your property and to evaluate access for fire trucks.

1. Enter Hwy 83 Mile Marker # closest to the road which intersects with Hwy 83 and provides access to your property.
2. Enter the name of that road.
3. Give directions to your house from that intersection. (*Good directions are critical for our emergency responders.*)
4. Enter your physical address and county. (*If you do not have a physical address, contact the County Surveyor's office and request assignment of an address. For Lake County call 883-7213 and for Missoula County 258-4866.*)
5. Enter total number of adults living at this location, number of those adults who would need special evacuation assistance from the response team, total number of children at this location, and number of those children who would need special evacuation assistance. (*Special needs should be detailed below in block 10*)
6. Indicate with a check mark whether you are a full-time resident, a seasonal or part-time resident, if this is a business location, or if this is undeveloped land.
- 7a. Enter name of occupant(s). If this is a business location, enter name of business.
- 7b. Enter phone number of occupant at this physical location. (*In the event of a fire threat or other emergency, attempts will be made to reach the property occupant and the property owner to alert them to the situation.*)
- 7c. Enter work phone number of occupant, if applicable.
- 8a. Enter name of property owner(s).
- 8b. Enter phone number of property owner. If you are a seasonal or part-time resident, use this space to enter a phone number where you can be reached when you are not in the Swan Valley.
- 9a. Enter name of alternate person to be contacted in event of a fire threat or other emergency and occupant or owner cannot be reached.
- 9b. Enter phone number for alternate contact.
10. Enter name of any occupant needing special help from the emergency response team, and detail special care needs (e.g. uses oxygen tank, requires wheelchair, uses walker, is blind). Special care requirements are not guaranteed by the emergency response team.
11. List any hazardous materials on the property, including propane and diesel storage tanks, and detail their locations. (*This knowledge will help protect firefighters.*)
12. In an emergency, owners are responsible for protection of their animals.
13. Indicate all available water sources for firefighting. If none, check "no".
14. If the water source is a pond or stream, do you have a portable pump to access it? If the water source is dependent on electricity, do you have a generator available in the event that electric power goes down? Indicate if applicable and working.
15. List all buildings on property (e.g. house with red roof, 30x40 metal workshop, garage, mobile home, etc.). Indicate which buildings are occupied. Indicate which buildings contain hazardous materials as described in #11.
16. Enter name of person who completed this form and date it was completed.
